3. Share information about yourself

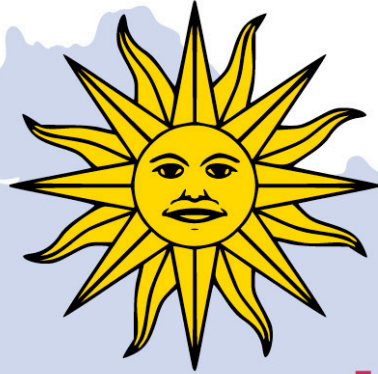
