

Any Key Club member in good standing, meaning club dues must be submitted and the club can be missing no more than one Monthly Report Form, is eligible to run for higher office, which can be done in one of two ways: 1. Candidates can declare their candidacy prior to District Convention (meaning campaign literature will be printed in our DCLC booklet) 2. Candidates can "run off the floor" (candidates will be nominated during Convention, literature will not be printed) Each candidate running for higher office must attend the following: Any mandatory meeting as determined by the Illinois-**Eastern Iowa District Board** Meet the Candidates session All General Sessions (please note candidates will be required to give a speech at one general session with time being dependent on position of interest) All assigned caucusing sessions House of Delegates, February 22th, 2025
